(LANDING BACK IN NEVERLAND - OPENING ACT 2)

PAN:

Now I know what a bungee jump must feel like.

WENDY:

I feel quite bruised, those pages have quite a rough edge.

MIKE:

I think I’ve got a paper cut.

TINKER:

My wings look like Wendy’s hair.

BO-BO:

How do you work that one out?

TINKER:

They’re all matted.

MIKE:

Why are we wearing these ridiculous clothes?

TINKER:

Because if you go back into your book you have to match your illustration.

PAN:

Things certainly look different around here.

TINKER:

It could certainly do with a little extra...(ENTER LITTLE EXTRA)

EXTRA:

Would I do?

TINKER:

I beg your pardon?

EXTRA:

I said, would I do?

BO-BO:

Who are you?

EXTRA:

I’m a little extra, well a ‘Walk-On’ really but I do do extra work occasionally, I was in “Harry Potter”, the dining room scene, though you couldn’t see me, I was behind the invisible chandelier, “Charlie and the Chocolate factory”, at the gates just as they go in, oh and I had a line in “Goal”.

PAN:

What was that?

EXTRA:

(SCREAMS) GOAL!

PAN:

Yes I know that but what was the line?

EXTRA:

That was.

PAN:

What was?

EXTRA:

(EXACTLY AS LAST TIME, SCREAMS) GOAL! I’ll do anything me, you name it I’ll do it.

WENDY:

Get off.

EXTRA:

What, now?

BO-BO:

Yes, now.

EXTRA:

Any particular style? Shakespeare... 'I shall leave thee to thine impetuous fate that only, the solid of heart, couldst' endure'. Or Dickens... 'Oh Mr Chizzelwuzzer it really was a splendid evening, you and your good lady wife are most welcome to return to my humble abode'. How about something a bit more contemporary, Willy Russell... **(LIVEPUDLIAN ACCENT)** 'Wurra' you lookin' at you snivvelin' little...

TINKER:

How about in the style of an actor who's about to be set upon by three men, an out of work actress and a fairy?

EXTRA:

Which is which.

ALL:

GET OFF!

EXTRA:

Oh, right I see, Bye...**(EXITS)**

WENDY:

I am not an out of work actress, I'm resting.

TINKER:

I shan't disturb you then.

MIKE:

I say Pan, what do you think we should do now?

PAN:

Can anyone remember what happened in the original story?

WENDY:

I think we've come in at chapter twelve, the bit where I got captured by Hook...

BO-BO:

And he got the Lost Boys.

PAN:

And Tinker got poisoned.

TINKER:

I had an upset stomach for weeks, I'm not doing that again.

WENDY:

Shame.

MIKE:

Don't forget about us, we went through it as well, Hook wanted us to be anti-royalists.

WENDY:

Well I hardly think that's comparable to being hoisted up twenty feet in a night-dress.

TINKER:

I thought you looked good from a distance.

WENDY:

How would you know? You were the other side of the island

TINKER:

Exactly.

WENDY:

TINKER:
